



### International Walk to School Month






### Communication

One of the areas of our School Improvement Plan this year is Mathematics. A focus is to support children to master a deeper understanding of the subject and develop numeracy skills which they can apply to other areas of the curriculum. This is a fantastic resource so that parents may have a greater understanding of how they can support their child/ren in Maths.

### Sacrament of Confirmation Y5/Y6


